1. What motivated you to start making layouts and begin stamping?

I started scrapbooking when I was 16 years old and got my very first job at a local scrapbook store. The first time I put photos on paper and added stickers, I was hooked! It's been 17 years since then and I think I enjoy scrapbooking even more and more!

2. How did you fall in love with Altenew?

I was invited to participate in a hop in the summer of 2017 and when I received the product I was so amazed by the quality of the stamps and coordinating metal dies, and inks, and sprays, and washi tapes, and MORE!

3. Your use of layers is amazing! Do you have a favorite technique to do? Please share some tips on them!

I love to use lots of bright colors on my layouts – the more the merrier! To help make the pages not too overwhelming I often like to do the tone-on-tone technique: pink embellishments over pink areas, mint embellishments over mint areas, yellow embellishments over yellow areas, etc. I also LOVE to use my Silhouette Cameo with cut files to make a big statement on my pages.

4. Do you have a specific style that you are comfortable with or like to stick to?

I like to use lots of patterned paper, repetition, and bright colors. Often, I like to use a large focal icon or title. And hand stitching – I feel like I can always add hand stitching somewhere!

5. Can you share a favorite project you made previously using Altenew products?

I have three favorite layouts! The first is called "Life Together" and it features four colorful quadrants filled with texture made from Altenew stencils and sprays along with some supplies from the Our Family collection. It was fun to get messy on this layout! The second is called "You Make My Heart Happy" and I had a blast stamping a whole bunch of layered flowers to create a frame! The third is called "XOXO" and this might be one of the first layouts where I really experimented with mixed media! I told myself to just go with the flow and be happy with whatever the results were!
